POLICY

Using an ever expanding set of hardware and software tools as well as policies and procedure SDSMT ITS endeavor to provide an open, safe and secure environment for its user community as well protecting SDSMT computing, networked resources and data.

PURPOSE

South Dakota School of Mines and Technology (SDSMT) Information Technology Services (ITS) will balance freedom of access, regulatory compliance and security to the best of its ability. In accordance with federal, state, local, SD Board of Regents and SDSMT requirements, South Dakota School of Mines and Technology (SDSMT) established a formal policy for regulatory compliance and industry best practices for computing and network security. This policy will be evaluated on an annual basis.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all computing and networking equipment and devices owned or controlled by SDSMT. This policy will directly and indirectly affect faculty, staff, students, volunteers and guests on the SDSMT campus and its environs.
